/transfer 4.1 – What's New?

Current Structures

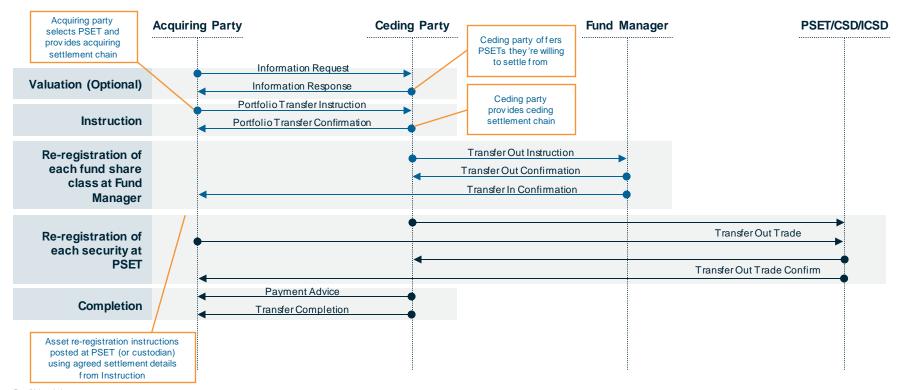
- Settlement details can only be exchanged for:
 - Funds
 - Settled at the Fund Manager
 - UK Equities and Bonds
 - Settled on CREST
- Non-UK Securities provided as "Other" assets
 - Free-format text
 - Valuation rather than unit amount
- ► All non-UK securities are processed manually outside the electronic transfer process

New Structures

- Negotiation of Place of Settlement
- Settlement details are exchanged for any:
 - Fund Share Class
 - Equity
 - Bond
- Settled at any of the 33 supported place of settlement (Inc Euroclear/Clearstream Bridge)
- Full settlement chain exchanged as required (custodian, sub-custodian, local agent, PSET)
- Straight through processing possible for all security assets



PSET Negotiation and Settlement Details



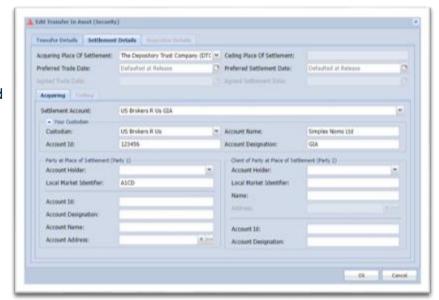


How does this work in /transfer?

- Automatically
 - Offer supported PSETs to the Acquiring Party
 - For a given scenario
 - E.g. based on the asset, wrapper, in vs out etc
 - Default PSET
 - Based on what you support and what the ceding party offered
 - Default Settlement Account details
 - For an agreed PSET and given scenario
 - E.g. just as nominee & CREST accounts are today

Enables

- Easy selection of PSET & Settlement Account details
- STP for non-UK securities
 - Reduced effort
 - Electronic messaging to Custodian
 - Integration with platform (or non-electronic custodian)
 - Reduced risk
 - Improved e2e transfer times





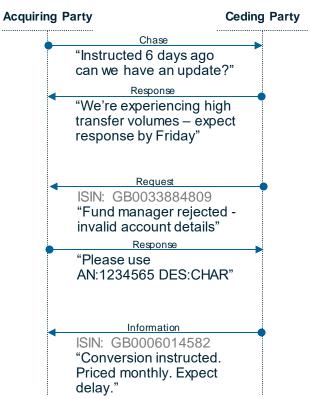

ViaNova Working Group



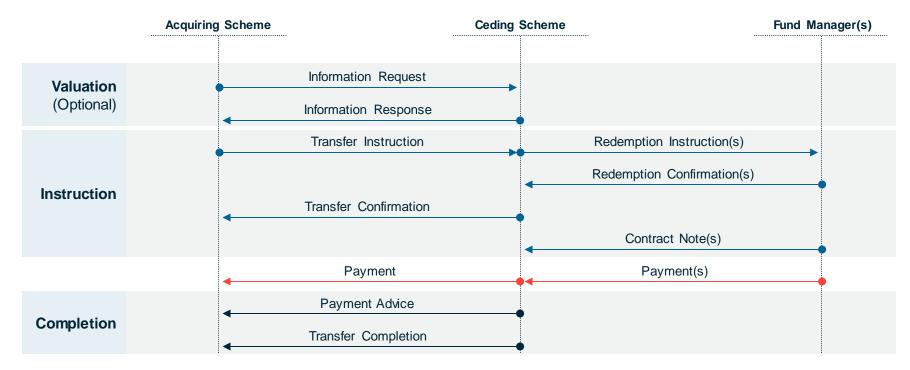
- Established in 2005 to establish and promote electronic open standards within the occupational pensions world
- Voluntary and free to join, supports collaboration among all stake holders involved occupational pensions
- Operates under the worldwide Securities Market Practise Group (SMPG)
- Promotes open standards based on ISO 20022 electronic messaging.
- Members include EPCs/TPAs, Fund Providers, Solution Providers.

- ViaNova for Fund automates all interactions between Pension Scheme Administrators and Fund Providers (Straight-Through-Processing/STP)
 - Daily price feeds
 - Daily statements/transaction statments
 - Dealing (subscriptions, redemptions, switches)
- ViaNova Transfers automates the transfer of DC and DB pensions
 - Started evaluating options in 2019
 - Selected TeX/UKETRG in 2021
 - Piloting through 2021/22
 - First live transfers in Q1-23

Benefits to Members and Trustees

Convenience

- Industry standard process
- Common declaration wording
- Backed by legal framework and electronic data standards

Speed

Much quicker transfers, from weeks or months down to days

Engagement

Keeping the member updated on progress is much easier with common processes and SLAs for each part of the process



Security

Layers upon layers of security: from the use of the SWIFT network, to strictly controlled FCA regulated community adhering to the TeX rules

Coverage

Demand will continue to grow for:

- DC and DB transfers
- · Growing number of participants
- "Green Lists" by administrators

Cash ISA Transfer Service Overview

Cash ISA Transfer Service (launched in 2012):

- Automated messaging service that manages the transfer from one ISA provider to another
- 78 participating brands
- 6+ million accounts transferred
- Facilitates the transfer of a Cash ISA into a number of variations of ISAs such as Stocks and Shares and Innovative Finance ISAs
- Reduces the time taken for end-to-end transfers. Industry SLA is 15 working days. Average transfer through the electronic service takes 6

Message Types

Happy Path

- Transfer Request
- Acceptance of Transfer
- Ready for Payment
- Confirmation of Completion

Alternative Messages

- Notification of Pend
- Notification of Referral
- Reject to Acquiring Party
- Notice of Abandonment
- Notification of Failure

CISA On-Boarding Journey - Application

- 1. Applicant completes CISA application form and NDA
- 2. Participant provides contacts for access to the CISA SharePoint on-boarding site.
- 3. Pay.UK provides access to the CISA documentation suite on SharePoint.
- 4. Introductory call held.



CISA On-Boarding Journey - Planning

- 1. Participant confirms the following:
 - a) Preferred testing window
 - b) CISA input channel
 - c) Sponsor/Registering Member/PKI provider
 - d) Payment channel CHAPS/FPS
- PKI Provider notified of application and test dates. Applicant orders test PKI and Cash ISA SUN from PKI provider
- 3. Applicant completes Participation Agreement

- 4. Applicant provides test data to VocaLink
- 5. CISA pre-testing call held
- 6. Code of Conduct provided to participant (available on SharePoint)



CISA On-Boarding Journey - Testing

- 1. Applicant/Pay.UK/Vocalink confirms readiness for testing
- 2. Applicant performs connectivity testing
- 3. Applicant completes all designated test scenarios with their CISA solution
- 4. VocaLink confirm successful completion of CISA testing
- 5. On successful completion of technical testing, 6 month "warranty" period initiated



CISA On-Boarding Journey – Go-Live

- 1. CISA Code of Conduct returned by participant
- 2. Applicant confirms proposed go-live date with both Pay.UK and TISA
- 3. Proposed live date shared with PKI provider, applicant orders live PKI and CISA SUN from PKI provider
- 4. Applicant completes DDI for monthly charging
- 5. Applicant provides details of anticipated volumes



CISA On-Boarding Journey – Go-Live (cont)

- 7. Applicant provides contact info for the following:
 - a) CISA Committee Reps
 - b) CISA Billing
 - c) CISA queries
- 8. Pre-go live call scheduled
- 9. Final go-live confirmation provided
- 10. Participant confirms successful go-live
- 11. Pay.UK inform Risk team of new applicant
- 12. Pay.UK issue Post Implementation Review
